Who is Eligible?

Young women in grades sixth through eighth are eligible for the Kellie Harper Women's Basketball Camp Scholarship. Each winner will receive an all-expense paid scholarship to attend the Kellie Harper Women's Basketball Camp in summer 2009. Contestants are to write a brief (around 300 words) essay from one of the two topics provided. Please provide **TYPED** essay answers on a separate sheet of paper, along with your application form. In order to be considered, all applicants must have a parent/guardian's signature next to all questions under the **Parental/Guardian Consent** portion of this application in order to be eligible for the scholarship.

Contest Guidelines:

- The contest is open to middle school/junior high school female students in sixth, seventh, eighth grades.

- Criteria for contest includes:
 - Originality and accuracy of written essay—55 percent
 - Scholastic and extracurricular activities—40 percent
 - Extra Credit question—5 percent
- Forms must be completed and returned by **March 26, 2010**.
- Please do not fill out with pencil! Use typewriter or attach computer printout.
- **HANDWRITTEN ENTRIES WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED.**

Parental/Guardian Consent:

I will familiarize myself with the medical requirements stated in the camp application materials, and certify by my application that my child is physically and mentally able to safely participate in the camp.
- I understand that available health care services at the camp do not include on-site care by a physician. Registered nurses and athletic trainers are on duty to oversee MINOR MEDICAL CONDITIONS only. The camp cannot accept students who cannot take part in normal camp routine and activities.
- I understand that the Kellie Harper Women's Basketball Camp management has right of refusal for any camper based on the above conditions and has the ability to terminate a camper's time at the camp due to an infraction of camp rules.
